

Mission update with a few pictures

Hello friends and family,

We are finally moved out to the property and wanted to send a few pictures so that you could see all that God has done for us. The pictures are of the first half of the industrial arts building which we are staying in till we get more buildings up. Notice that there are two entrance doors because the room is divided with a partition. Our family is staying in one half (16 feet by 11 feet minus the walls) and the guys are staying in the other half. 11 x 16 is larger than a tent but since we have the kitchen and dining room table in the room with us it is rather crowded. In the background to the right of the building you can see the "bath house" which is a combination toilet and shower rooms separated with partitions.

The next picture is another angle of the IA building with our faithful Nisan Double Cab in the foreground. Just behind where I took this picture we are putting up fence for the garden because the local Masai shepherds like to bring their herds of cows, goats, and sheep to graze during the day and the baboons and deer like to graze on our garden during the night.

The last picture is a close up of the bath house. Just behind where I stood to take this last photo will be the men's dorm which is the next building that we will work on. When we complete the men's dorm we will be able to move the kitchen and dining room into the other side of the IA building and it will almost seem "roomy".

Thank you to each of you who have prayed for and supported us in this project. We have people asking us regularly "when will you start school?". We hope to start in March but there is much to be done to have room for holding classes. Please continue to pray for us as it seems that each step forward is against supernatural forces. God is faithful and is winning our battles one at a time.

Our internet is continuing to be a challenge so I am praying that this goes through.
